### Key thoughts/ideas

A prophetic word consists of -

- a. You can be confident that when you ask Him for a word for someone he will answer because it's who He is. (Luke 11:10-13)
- b. The Holy Spirit uses the word to prophesy and back up what He is saying. Become familiar and memorise the word to use in prophecy.
- c. Prophecy was given for exhortation, edification and comfort. (1 Cor. 14:3)
- d. A mistake doesn't make you a false prophet. It's about your heart motive.
