Key thoughts/ideas

Purity of your heart: From the wellspring of your heart, the mouth speaks. New heart
 = new nature.

- Correcting 'Bad Bodyology'- You body is a temple. It is not evil, not 'fleshly', not 'new age' to get in touch with your body. It is God's chosen vessel- Christ saw it fit to take on flesh.

- Prophesy- an expression of love designed to communicate something of the Father's heart. Zeph 3:17.
