- a. You can be confident that when you ask Him for a word for someone he will answer because it's who He is. (Luke 11:10-13)

- c. Prophecy was given for exhortation, edification and comfort. (1 Cor. 14:3)
- d. A mistake doesn't make you a false prophet. It's about your heart motive.

- a. Be positive! Look for the good, not for the evil.

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- b. Be brief. Length doesn't equate to anointing.

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- c. Be kind. Don't embarrass people.

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- d. As we learn, we don't prophesy directional words - dates, mates and babies or major life changes. Conversationally is the best way.

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- e. Be humble. It's okay to ask questions!

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- f. Be bold. Be wise.
