Key thoughts/ideas

You can be confident that when you ask Him for a word for someone He will answer becaus it's who He is. (Luke 11:10-13)
The Holy Spirit uses the word to prophesy and back up what He is saying. Become familiar and memorise the word to use in prophecy.
Prophecy was given for exhortation, edification and comfort. (1 Corinthians 14:3)

How to hear:

- a. Make time to chat
- b. Ask the Holy Spirit to speak to your mind
- c. Be lead by peace

Protocols

- a. Be positive! Look for the good, not for the evil."Look for the treasure, not the trash." Kris Vallotton
- b. Be brief. Length does not equate to anointing.
- c. Be kind. Don't embarrass people.
- d. As we learn, we don't prophesy directional words dates, mates and babies or major life changes. Conversationally is the best way.
- e. Be humble. It's ok to ask questions!
- f. Be bold. Be wise.



c.	No Compromise Obedience Willingness to do what He says, go where He tells you is key. It's based on knowing who He is and trusting that His plans for you are good. In this world we have trouble, but we as prophets have the joyful privilege to impart hope, pointing to the One who has overcome the world, releasing people, regions and nations into what the Lord has for them.
d.	Practice, practice What does this look like in a day to day?
e.	The greatest of these is Love Why do we do it? Love doesn't mean we can't truth tell. There's a way to pull people up into the higher that the Lord has for them. Don't confuse prayer with prophecy.
f.	There doesn't have to be a distinction between "prophetic time" and "non-prophetic time." Everyday, ordinary life, even conversations can be prophetic. Give your days to God, be aware of Him always. Ps 16:8 I have set the Lord always before me God is always speaking, and always has something to say. There is no need to turn on the prophetic hotspot when you need and then turn it off again. Be natural, prophecy doesn't become prophecy with a microphone, or even inside of a church building. It can be as natural as an idea popping into your head during the day, or during conversation with someone.
